Cookie Notice

Strictly Necessary Cookies for Ebix Europe Limited (“**Ebix**”). Notice last revised on 28th August 2024.

This Cookie Notice describes the several types of cookies and similar technologies that may be applied by Ebix Europe that link to this Cookie Notice.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that a website transfers to your hard drive or device to store and sometimes collect information about your usage of websites, such as time spent on the sites, pages visited, language preferences, and other traffic data. We use the information for security purposes, to facilitate navigation, to display information more effectively, to personalise your experience while using the Sites and to recognise your computer to assist your use of the Sites. We also gather statistical information about use of the Sites to improve their design and functionality, understand how they are used and assist us with resolving questions regarding them.

There are several types of cookies, for example:

- Cookies transferred directly by Ebix Europe Limited or the website vendor ('first party cookies') and cookies transferred on our behalf, for example by our selected advertisers and data analytics companies ('third party cookies')
- Cookies which endure for different periods of time, including those that only last only as long as your browser is open (referred to as 'session cookies'). These are deleted automatically from your device once you close your browser. Other cookies are 'permanent cookies', meaning that they remain on your device after your browser is closed. For example, they recognise your device when you open your browser and browse the internet again.

What cookies do we use?

Below are the several types of cookies and similar technologies that may be used on the Sites. Where we use third party cookies, we provide a link to the third party's cookie policy.

If the cookies listed below collect any Personal Information (or 'PII': information that identifies, relates to, describes, or is capable of being associated, linked or linkable with a particular individual or household), then our [Privacy Policy · Ebix Europe](#) applies and supplements this Cookie Notice. We encourage you to review the above, which describes our collection, use, disclosure, and processing of personal information that we collect.

Strictly Necessary Cookies: these cookies enable you to navigate the Sites and to use the services and features. Without these necessary cookies and similar technologies, the Sites will not perform as

smoothly for you as we would like them to, and we may not be able to provide the Sites or certain services or features.

How do I manage cookies?

You can control the way in which cookies are used by altering your browser settings. You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to reject cookies. Information about the procedure to follow to enable or disable cookies can be found on your Internet browser provider's website via your help screen.

Please note that if you choose not to accept cookies, this will affect the functioning of our Sites.

If you are using a mobile device, you can limit interest-based advertising on your device by adjusting the settings provided by your device manufacturer, such as "Limit Ad Tracking" for iOS or "Opt-out of interest-based ads" for Android.
